## Council Minutes

### Special meeting

March 29, 2004

Mayor Nolan announced this special meeting was scheduled for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing on Ordinance 8-04 an Ordinance concerning zoning on the fifteen acres owned by David Schafer in the Borough; however he will read a letter from Mr. Albert Cruz Special Council to Rocky Hill Borough Concerning Land Use Issues. The letter advised Borough Council not to proceed with the Public Hearing as there may not have been adequate notice of the Special Meeting of the Rocky Hill Planning Board held on March 22, 2004 to review the Ordinance 8-04.
